Aloha Is Our Future and Hope

Question: What's my God given goal, purpose or kuleana for my family and community?

(John 13:35 NIV) **By this** everyone will know that you are **my disciples**, if you **love one another**."

Problem:

- 1. Do you tend to isolate and distance yourself from people who are scary, difficult, different, who have used or abused you and so on prior to COVID-19?
- 2. Could it be that we have people in our families that we love but we can't stand being with them (Genesis 3)?
- 3. Could it be that we have good kids and family members but we can't get them to stop fighting (Genesis4:13-14)?
- 4. Could it be that we have the wrong plans, goals and tools in our relationships (Malachi 4:6)?
- 5. If so, what's God's plan and our part of His plan to overcome social isolation and distancing?

Guide: Holy Spirit

<u>Plan</u>:

- 1. What's God's plan or kuleana for me?
 - a) (John 3:16-17 NKJV) 16 For God so <u>loved</u> the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to <u>condemn</u> the world, but that the world through Him might be <u>saved</u>.
 - b) God's plan is to comfort, add value, worth, honor, strength to me, my family and community
 - c) God's plan is to empower and teach me to create a safe, healthy, and hopeful Hawaii that no child or person would have to live in fear or abuse.
- 2. What's my part of God's goal and plan? Is it connection or distance?
 - a) Can you imagine a football game without an end zone or goal post? It would be meaningless and frustrating. That's what life, family and community can be like without a personal commitment to God's goal, plan, purpose and kuleana for my family and community.

Call to action: Aloha Challenge

- 1. Commit to loving to hearing, following and obeying Jesus. (Cat and Dog Theology)
- 2. Commit to loving to hearing and sharing the Word and Spirit of God.
