When Jesus walked the earth, He gave His followers more than one hundred life changing promises and teachings for living in line with God's priorities to overcome fear, worry, anxiety, frustration, anger, depression, punishment and other hurts, habits, hang-ups. Here's how to be the unstoppable Ekklesia.

(Matthew 22:37-40) Jesus replied, "'You must <u>love the Lord your God</u> with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.'[e] 38 This is the <u>first and greatest commandment</u>. 39 A <u>second is equally important</u>: '<u>Love your neighbor</u> as yourself.' 40 The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

Do you want to know the bible? Know how to live out Matthew 22:37-40 by following 3 points below every day, all day.

Jesus Ekklesia was unstoppable because it's love connections I call the Aloha triangle (Up, In, Out):

- 1. Loved God supremely, Trusted God completely, Obeyed God wholeheartedly, Praised God continually
- 2. Loved each another sacrificially
- 3. Loved one another unconditionally

(1 John 4:18 NLT) **Such <u>love</u> has <u>no fear</u>, because <u>perfect love</u> <u>expels all fear</u>. If we are afraid, it is for <u>fear of</u> <u>punishment</u>, and this shows that we have <u>not fully experienced his perfect love</u>.**

(John 15:12) This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you.

(John 14:15-17 GOD'S WORD Translation) ¹⁵ "If you love me, you will obey my commandments.

God is looking for people who **love Him** enough to **obey Him** and to share His love with everyone instead of doing their own will. Jesus Ekklesia was:

- 1. Dynamic
- 2. expansive, 24/7 people movement
- 3. Unstoppable potential to grow and change the world.
- 4. They were able to do this because of its Culture of Honor and Love.
- 5. It's that supernatural culture's ability to attract and host the power, promises and presence of God.

- What will you do in the next 7 days to get back into balance? Complete the following sentence: "I will...in the next 7 days to get back into balance in my Aloha triangle."
- 3. Take 90 seconds and ask our Father, what are 3 things He loves about the people in your group?
- 4. Have someone close in prayer
