1. What does a biblical culture look like according to Matt. 16:18, Matt. 18:20, Acts 2:42-47?

- a) (Matthew 16:18 NLT) Now I say to you that you are Peter (which means 'rock'), and upon this rock I will build my church (Ekklesia), and all the powers of hell will not conquer it.
 - YOU are Jesus Ekklesia! The person of God, the people of God, not the place of God!
 - God has blessed you to be the vibrant, expansive, 24/7 people movement with unstoppable capacity for growth
 - God has anointed you to set the pace and agenda for society
- b) (Matt. 18:20 NLT) where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them."
 - It's about YOU and 2 (no more) to attract and host the power and presence of Jesus
- c) (Acts 2:42-47 NLT) 42 All the believers <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' <u>teaching</u>, and to <u>fellowship</u>, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to <u>prayer</u>. 43 A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed <u>many miraculous signs and wonders</u>. 44 And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. 45 They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. 46 They <u>worshiped together</u> at the Temple each day, met in <u>homes</u> for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity— 47 all the while <u>praising God</u> and <u>enjoying the goodwill of all the people</u>. And each day <u>the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved</u>.
