 - a) (Exodus 18:21 NLT) But select from all the people some <u>capable</u>, <u>honest</u> men who <u>fear God</u> and <u>hate bribes</u>.
 Appoint them as leaders over groups of one thousand, one hundred, fifty, and ten.
 - b) (Matthew 28:18-20 NLT) Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. 19 Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. 20 Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
 - c) (Matthew 5:14-16) 14 "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.

- 2. **Support** our government (Matt. 22:21; Matt. 17:24-27; Rom. 13:6)
- 3. **Submit** to our government (1 Pet. 2:13-14, 17; Rom. 13:2-5)
- 4. **Stand up** to our government (Exod. 2:15-21; Dan. 6:1-23; Acts 5:29)
- 5. Select our government (Exodus 18:19-21; Exodus 20:1-17)
 - a) Vote for leaders who will protect religious freedoms (Ex. 20:1-11)
 - b) Vote for leaders who will protect <u>natural and healthy marriages</u> (Ex. 20:12; 14)
 - c) Vote for leaders who will protect <u>life from the womb to the tomb</u> (Ex. 12:13)
 - d) Vote for leaders who will protect our property and constitutional rights (Ex. 20:15)
 - e) Vote for leaders who will protect ethical, moral, and biblical prosperity (Ex. 20:17)
